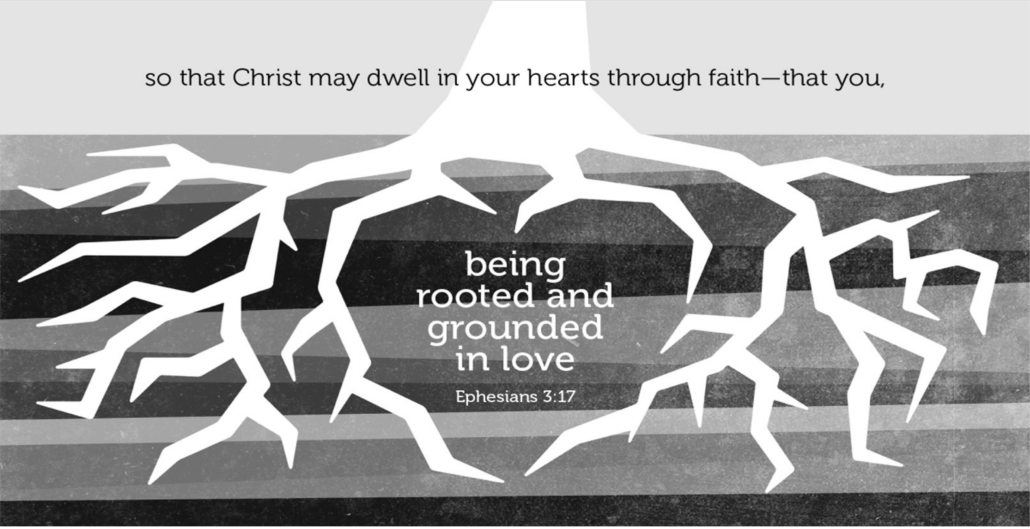


Root Beer Floats
